<i>Anemone Canadensis</i>	Canadian anemone - 24"	Part Shade/Shade, Moist
<i>Anemone thalictroides</i>	Rue anemone - 18"	Part Sun/Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Aquilegia canadensis</i>	Eastern/wild red columbine - 30"	Part Shade/Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Asarum canadensis</i>	Wild ginger - 12"	Shade/Part Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Asclepias tuberosa</i>	Butterfly milkweed - 24"	Sun/Part Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Asclepias incarnata</i>	Marsh milkweed - 36"	Sun/Part Shade, Wet/Moist
<i>Aster divaricatus</i>	White wood aster - 18"	Sun/Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Aster novae angliae</i>	New England aster - 36"	Sun/Part Sun, Moist
<i>Caltha palustris</i>	Marsh marigold - 18"	Part Sun/Shade, Wet
<i>Campanula rotundifolia</i>	Bellflower, Harebell - 24"	Sun/Part Shade/Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Chelone glabra</i>	Turtlehead - 36"	Part Shade, Wet/Moist
<i>Coreopsis lanceolata</i>	Lanceleaf tickseed - 24"	Sun/Part Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Echinacea purpurea</i>	Purple coneflower - 30"	Sun/Part Shade, Moist
<i>Eupatorium maculatum</i>	Spotted Joe-Pye weed - 50"	Sun/Part Sun, Wet/Moist
<i>Eupatorium perfoliatum</i>	Boneset - 36"	Sun/Part Sun, Moist
<i>Geranium maculatum</i>	Wild geranium - 18"	Part Shade/Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Iris versicolor</i>	Blue flag iris - 36"	Sun/Part Shade, Wet/Lake Edge
<i>Liatris spicata</i>	Northern blazing star, Gayfeather - 36"	Sun/Part Sun, Wet/Moist
<i>Lobelia cardinalis</i>	Cardinal flower - 36"	Sun/Part Shade/Shade, Wet/Moist
<i>Lobelia siphilatica</i>	Great blue lobelia - 30"	Sun/Part Sun/Shade, Wet/Moist
<i>Lupinus perennis</i>	Wild lupine - 24"	Sun/Part Shade, Dry
<i>Monarda didyma</i>	Scarlet beebalm, red bergamot - 40"	Sun/Part Shade, Wet/Moist
<i>Monarda fistulosa</i>	Wild bergamot, Beebalm - 40"	Sun/Part Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Onoclea sensibilis</i>	Sensitive fern - 24"	Part Sun/Full Shade, Wet/Moist
<i>Osmunda cinnamomea</i>	Cinnamon fern - 60"	Sun/Shade, Moist
<i>Osmunda claytoniana</i>	Interrupted fern - 36"	Shade, Moist
<i>Osmunda regalis</i>	Royal fern - 72"	Shade/Part Shade, Moist
<i>Penstemon calycosus</i>	Calico beardtongue - 36"	Full Sun, Drought Tolerant
<i>Penstemon digitalis</i>	Beardtongue - 36"	Sun/Part Shade, Wet/Moist/Dry

<i>Penstemon hirsutus</i>	Hairy beardtongue - 14"	Sun/Part Shade/Shade, Dry
<i>Phlox divaricata</i>	Wild blue phlox, Woodland phlox - 28"	Sun/Part Shade, Moist
<i>Phlox subulata</i>	Ground phlox, Moss pink - 6"	Sun/Part Shade, Well-drained
<i>Physostegia virginiana</i>	Obedient plant, False dragonhead - 36"	Sun/Shade, Moist
<i>Polemonium reptans</i>	Jacobs ladder, Greek valerian - 18"	Shade, Moist
<i>Polystichum acrostichoides</i>	Christmas fern - 16"	Part Shade/Shade, Moist
<i>Rudbeckia hirta</i>	Blackeyed Susan, Gloriosa daisy - 42"	Sun/Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Rudbeckia laciniata</i>	Green headed coneflower - 48"	Sun/Shade, Moist
<i>Sanguinaria canadensis</i>	Bloodroot - 8"	Part Sun/Shade, Moist/Drained
<i>Silene virginica</i>	Scarlet catchfly, Fire pink - 30"	Part Shade, Moist/dry
<i>Silphium perfoliatum</i>	Cup plant - 60"	Sun, Wet/Moist/Dry
<i>Thalictrum dasycarpum</i>	Tall meadow rue - 48"	Sun/Part Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Tradescantia bracteata</i>	Spiderwort - 24"	Sun/Part Sun, Moist/Dry
<i>Tiarella cordifolia</i>	Heart leaf foamflower - 12"	Shade, Moist
<i>Verbena hastata</i>	Blue vervain - 48"	Sun/ Part Sun, Moist
<i>Zizia aurea</i>	Golden Alexanders - 24"	Sun/Shade, Moist

NATIVE GRASSES:

<i>Andropogon gerardi</i>	Big blue stem - 80"	Sun, Moist/Dry
<i>Carex crinita</i>	Fringed sedge - 36"	Sun/Part Shade, Wet/Moist
<i>Carex pennsylvanica</i>	Pennsylvania sedge - 9"	Sun/Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Elymus hystrix</i>	Bottlebrush grass - 48"	Sun/Shade, Wet/Dry
<i>Juncus effusus</i>	Sofrush - 36"	Sun/Part Sun, Wet/Moist
<i>Schizachyrium scoparium</i>	Little blue stem - 24"	Sun, Dry

NATIVE SHRUBS OR BUSHES:

<i>Amelanchier arborea</i>	Downy serviceberry - 10 to 20'	Sun/Shade, Moist/Dry
<i>Cephalanthus occidentalis</i>	Buttonbush - 6 to 10'	Sun, Wet/Moist
<i>Clethra alnifolia</i>	Summersweet - 5 to 8'	Sun/Part Sun, Moist
<i>Cornus oblique</i>	Silky dogwood - 6 to 12'	Sun/Part Sun, Moist
<i>Cornus racemosa</i>	Gray dogwood - 8 to 10'	Sun/Shade, Wet/Dry
<i>Cornus sericea</i>	Red Osier dogwod - 7 to 10'	Sun, Moist/Dry
<i>Hamamelis virginiana</i>	Witch hazel - 8 to 20'	Sun/Shade, Moist
<i>Ilex verticillata</i>	Winterberry - 10' high and wide	Sun/Shade, Moist/Wet
<i>Itea virginica</i>	Virginia sweet spire - 8'	Sun/Shade, Moist/Wet
<i>Lindera benzoin</i>	Spicebush - 6 to 10'	Sun/Shade, Wet/Moist/Dry
<i>Physocarpus opulifolius</i>	Eastern ninebark - 5 to 9'	Sun/Part Sun, Wet/Dry
<i>Sambucus canadensis</i>	Elderberry - 5 to 10'	Sun/Part Sun, Moist
<i>Vaccinium corymbosum</i>	Highbush blueberry - 6 to 10'	Sun/Part Sun, Moist/Drained
